Lutnick lunch on island, Musk asks about parties, Trump referenced

WASHINGTON : (AGENCY)

The US Justice Department on Friday published millions of new files related to the convicted sex offender Jeffrey Epstein, including emails that showed Howard Lutnick, President Donald Trump's Commerce Secretary, apparently visited Epstein's private island for lunch years after he claimed to have cut off ties. In another set of emails, billionaire and former Trump adviser Elon Musk asked whether Epstein was planning any parties but declined an invitation to visit the island. In a reflection of the elite circles Epstein inhabited, the documents included mentions of many prominent figures in politics, business and entertainment, including Trump himself, who was friends with Epstein years before his crimes came to light. For instance, Kevin Warsh, whom Trump nominated on Friday as the next chairman of the Federal Reserve, appeared in an email from a



publicist to Epstein listing 43 people, including celebrities such as Martha Stewart, headed to a Christmas gathering. It was not clear whether Warsh knew Epstein or why Epstein was sent the note, and Warsh did not immediately comment. Previous document releases have renewed scrutiny of Epstein's relationships with other prominent people, including former President Bill Clinton and former Treasury Secretary Larry Summers, who have denied wrongdoing.

Todd Blanche, the US deputy attorney general, said Friday's batch of documents marked the end of the Trump administration's planned releases under a law calling for all Epstein-related files to be made public. The new cache includes more than 3 million pages, 2,000 videos and 180,000 images, he said at a press conference. Trump has denied any knowledge of Epstein's crimes. But the scandal has dogged him for

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months, in part because he promised to release the files during his 2024 presidential campaign then reneged after taking office. The newly published files included hundreds of documents that mention Trump, many of which were collections of media reports. One file details what appeared to be internal emails by federal investigators looking into salacious accusations involving the President and Epstein. The emails, all from August 2025, give no indication that any claims had been substantiated, and investigators noted several of the accusers were deemed not credible. The Justice Department said in a press release that some of the documents contained

untrue and sensationalist claims against Trump. Another message, whose sender and recipient were both redacted, reads, "What does JE think of going to Mar-a-Lago after xmas instead of his island" referring to Trump's Florida club. The message is from 2012, years after Trump said the two men stopped socialising. The files also included what appeared to be a 2002 email from Melania Trump to Ghislaine Maxwell, Epstein's partner and co-conspirator, about a New York Magazine piece on Epstein. "Nice story about JE in NY mag. You look great on the picture," the email says. "Give me a call when you are back in NY." Maxwell was convicted in 2021 of sex trafficking a minor and other charges and sentenced to 20 years in prison. Epstein died in jail in 2019 while awaiting trial. Emails show Epstein and Lutnick made plans to meet for lunch on December 23, 2012, on Epstein's Caribbean.

200 killed in coltan mine collapse in eastern Congo

At least 200 people were killed earlier this week when a landslide collapsed several mines at a major coltan mining site in eastern Congo, rebel authorities said on Saturday. The collapse took place on Wednesday at the Rubaya mines, which are controlled by the M23 rebels, Lumumba Kambere Muyisa, the spokesperson of the rebel-appointed governor of North-Kivu province, told The Associated Press. He said the landslide was caused by heavy rains. "For now, there are more than 200 dead, some of whom are still in the mud and have not yet been recovered," Muyisa

said. He added that several others were injured and taken to three health facilities in the town of Rubaya, while ambulances were expected to transfer the wounded on Saturday to Goma, the nearest city around 50 kilometres (30 miles) away. The rebel-appointed governor of North Kivu has temporarily halted artisanal mining on the site and ordered the relocation of residents who had built shelters near the

mine, Muyisa said. Rubaya lies in the heart of eastern Congo, a mineral-rich part of the Central African nation which for decades has been ripped apart by violence from government forces and different armed groups, including the Rwanda-backed M23, whose recent resurgence has escalated the conflict, worsening an already acute humanitarian crisis. Over 15 per cent of the world's supply of tantalum, a rare metal extracted from coltan that is a key component in the production of smartphones, computers and aircraft engines, comes from the Rubaya region. In May 2024, M23 seized the town and took control of its mines.

Iraqi calligrapher's handwritten Quran ends 6 years of artistry, craft

Iraqi calligrapher Ali Zaman gazes with pride at his masterpiece - a colossal, handwritten manuscript of the Quran that has taken six years of craft and devotion to complete. The finished work consists of 302 dou-



ble-sided scrolls, each measuring 4 metres (13 feet) in length and 1.5 metres in width. The sheets, resembling heavy parchment, were custom-made for Zaman with a blend of traditional materials including eggs, corn starch and alum. "Anytime I think of this Quran, it gives me a very nice feeling that the mighty God gave me the life to be able to finish this thing and complete it. I feel very proud," the 54-year-old told The Associated Press at a mosque in Istanbul where the manuscript is kept. Islamic calligraphy is regarded as one of the most

valued artistic traditions in the Muslim world. The art form served to preserve and embellish Islam's holy book and was later also used to adorn mosques, palaces and manuscripts. In Turkiye, it flourished during the Ottoman era when the art was supported by the state, and calligraphers developed distinctive styles. Art expert Umit Coskunsu says that because of the Islamic tradition's restrictions on depicting figures, calligraphy became a central form of artistic expression. He describes "hat" as a form of worship. "The art of hat is not just calligraphy, it is seen as a means of worshipping God and coming closer to Him," Coskunsu said. Zaman was born in Ranya, a town in Sulaymaniyah governorate, in Iraq's northern semi-autonomous Kurdish region. He moved his family to Istanbul in 2017 to pursue his Quran project and to hone his craft because, he says, the art of calligraphy is more valued in Turkiye than in his home country. Zaman says he developed an interest in Islamic calligraphy around the age of 12 when he was first exposed to it in Iraq. "The art of calligraphy was very attractive to me.

'Ashamed of begging for money': Why Pakistan Prime Minister 'can't say no to many things'

Pakistan's Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif has expressed frustration over his country's reliance on foreign loans, stating that seeking financial aid undermines national self-respect and is a source of embarrassment for officials, including Army Chief Asim Munir. Addressing Pakistan's prominent exporters and business leaders at an event in Islamabad, Sharif emphasised the burden of debt on Pakistan's dignity, indicating the need for alternative economic strategies.



"We feel ashamed when Field Marshal Asim Munir and I go around the world BEGGING for money. Taking loans is a huge burden on our self-respect. Our heads bow down in shame. We cannot say NO to many things they want us to do," said Pakistan PM Shehbaz Sharif as reported by local broadcaster A1tv. Sharif's admission of "begging" for loans highlights the country's economic struggles and reliance on international assistance. This comes as Pakistan seeks IMF support and debt rollovers. He also praised "all-weather friend" China, along with Saudi

Arabia, the UAE, and Qatar, which have supported Islamabad through both good times and bad, regardless of circumstances. Pakistan's economic lifelines are heavily reliant on China, Saudi Arabia, the UAE, and Qatar, which provide critical financial support to stabilise foreign exchange reserves and prevent a balance-of-payments crisis. China has rolled over billions in safe deposits to help Pakistan meet debt obligations, with \$4 billion projected for 2024-25. The China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) is a key framework, with over \$60 billion in energy and infrastructure investments. Saudi Arabia extended a \$3 billion deposit with the State Bank of Pakistan in December 2024 and provided a deferred oil payment facility of approximately \$1.2 billion in 2025. Riyadh has pledged significant investments in mining, agriculture, and IT, with

potential plans totalling \$5-\$25 billion.

The UAE rolled over a \$2 billion loan in early 2025 and committed to investing billions in Pakistan's energy, port operations, and wastewater treatment sectors, targeting \$10-25 billion.

Qatar signed a protocol to realize \$3 billion in investments, focusing on aviation, agriculture, and hospitality, and is a key energy supplier, particularly for LNG. These countries are crucial for Pakistan's economic stability, with investments and aid flowing through frameworks like the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) and the Special Investment Facilitation Council (SIFC). Sharif also raised concerns about rising poverty and unemployment and lamented the lack of development in R&D and innovation. Pakistan is facing a severe socioeconomic crisis with poverty rates estimated to have risen towards 45% of the population, exacerbated by inflation and floods. Unemployment has climbed to around 7.1%, with over eight million citizens jobless, while exports remain heavily reliant.

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Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque welcomes nearly 7 million guests in 2025

The Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque Centre received 6,846,723 guests in 2025, representing a 4 percent increase compared to 2024, and recording the highest annual figure in its history. The number of worshippers reached 1,531,192, including 257,859 who performed Friday (Jumu'ah) prayers, 697,961 who performed daily prayers, and 575,372 who attended during Ramadan and the two Eids. The number of iftar guests reached 898,767, while the number of visitors totalled 4,331,046. Users of the Mosque Promenade reached 85,718.

Guests from outside the UAE comprised 82 percent of total visitors, while UAE residents represented 18 percent. Asia topped the list of guests by continent at 49 percent, followed by Europe at 33 percent, North America at 11 percent, Africa and South America at 3 percent each, and Australia at 1 percent. By nationality, India ranked first at 20 percent of total guests, followed by China at 9 percent, Russia and the United States came third at 8 percent each. Germany, the United Kingdom,

France, and Italy ranked fourth at 3 percent each, followed by the Philippines and Pakistan at 2 percent each. A total of 55,730 guests joined the cultural tours delivered by the Centre's cultural tour specialists across 4,031 tours. In addition, 21,988 guests were received as part of official delegations, with 1,564 bookings recorded. The Mosque also welcomed 335 high level delegations, including visits by 9 heads of state, 2 vice presidents, 4 state governors and 1 deputy governor, 8 sheikhs and princes, 12 prime ministers and 2 deputy prime ministers, 6 parliamentary speakers and 1 deputy speaker, 78 ministers, 25 deputy ministers, 51 ambassadors and consuls, 3

deputy ambassadors/consuls, one visit by religious denominations, 70 visits from the military sector, and 62 official visits by delegations from various entities. During Ramadan and Eid Al Fitr, the total number of guests reached 1,890,144 (worshippers and visitors). Throughout the holy month and the Eid Al Fitr holiday, 594,236 performed prayers at the Mosque: 193,435 attended Isha and Taraweeh, 195,987 attended Tahajjud, 72,533 marked the 27th night of Ramadan, and 26,025 performed Eid Al Fitr prayer.

During the same period, the Mosque received 391,011 visitors. Over the Eid Al Fitr holiday days, total guests reached 122,819, including 57,629 worship-

pers and 64,959 visitors--reflecting a 10 percent increase compared to 1445H. Through the 'Our Fasting Guests' initiative, the Centre distributed 2,625,568 iftar and suhoor meals, sponsored by the Zayed Humanitarian Legacy Foundation, and delivered in partnership with Erth Hotel. This included 898,767 meals at Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque - Abu Dhabi, 442,345 meals at Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Grand Mosque in Al Ain, 1,160,000 meals in labour accommodations in Abu Dhabi, 105,935 meals in various areas across the Emirate of Abu Dhabi, and 19,000 suhoor meals distributed at the Mosque during the last ten nights of Ramadan. Throughout the year, the Centre continued enhancing guests' experiences by developing its cultural tours and diversifying services, including the Souq Al Jami' marketplace. The Centre also strengthened its civilizational presence locally and internationally through initiatives such as 'Minarets of the Two Capitals' in Moscow as part of the Jusoor Programme, and participation in the St. Petersburg International Forum of Religions.
